

ReachOut Policy Plan 2021

Origin

Since 2016, ReachOut has supported a group of around eight students. In the first years, the supported students went to a secondary school. A number of them successfully completed secondary school and were interested to move to the next level, that is, a vocational training or a university education. ReachOut has continued its support to these students as it is the foundation's goal to help the students until they reach the capacity to take care of themselves by finding a good job and being independent and responsible citizens.

Continued support for our students

In 2021, ReachOut will continue to make funds available to support the students it had adopted before (see the list below). Unfortunately, the COVID-19 pandemic has slowed down various difficulties, including the educational programmes, but everything will be done to give the usual support to the students. It is expected that several of the students that we support, will graduate in the course of 2021.
