Origin

Since 2016, ReachOut has supported a group of around eight students. In the first years, the supported students went to a secondary school. A number of them successfully completed secondary school and were interested to move to the next level, that is, a vocational training or a university education. ReachOut has continued its support to these students as it is the foundation's goal to help the students until they reach the capacity to take care of themselves by finding a good job and being independent and responsible citizens.

Continued support for our students

In 2022, ReachOut will continue to make funds available to support the students it had adopted before. Moreover, the students who had graduated have been replaced by a number of new students whose education ReachOut will finance. These are:
